



Requirements for the Undergraduate Minor in Bioethics, Humanities and Society

To have this Minor appear on your transcript, you **MUST**:

1. **Sign up for the Minor by downloading, completing and submitting the BHS Student Form (PDF) to bhs@msu.edu.** The form is available at bioethics.msu.edu/bhs/sign-up. The form must be completed in full.
2. **Complete a minimum of 5 courses totalling at least 15 credits.** Two courses shall be selected from the A list and three courses from the B list. **No more than 8 of the 15 credits may be in the same discipline.**
3. **Contact the BHS Advisor to confirm requirements have been met** early in the semester of intended graduation. **If you are graduating in the summer, please contact the BHS advisor the Spring semester before you intend to graduate.**
