Recurrent and Neglected Ethical Issues in the Psychiatric Brain Stimulation Discussion

What are key ethical concerns surrounding the use of *psychiatric* deep brain stimulation (DBS)? Are those concerns shared broadly for all aspects of DBS or alternatively are they specific to the intended targeted use of that intervention? Dr. Cabrera will discuss results from a recent study conducted by a multidisciplinary research team in which they examined ethical issues discussed in both the scientific and ethics literature around *psychiatric* DBS.
