-  Talk to us about work. We will ask you things like what works mean to you, if it's easy or hard, and if people at work are understanding (30 minutes to 2 hours).
-  Take photos about work (30 minutes to 2 hours).
-  Invite us to go to work with you and see what it's like (up to 40 hours).
-  Invite someone who helps you with work to talk to us too.
